This is probably happening because your browser is interpreting it as PHP code instead of a list of urls. The first thing I would do is change your download code to something like the following:

. In a window explorer: How can I get the file names to be readable? A: Windows Explorer displays extensions by default. Just right click on a file and choose "Properties" to display all file information. Is it crazy to be looking forward to the possibility of Bernie Sanders getting the Democratic nomination for President of the United States? I've also heard plenty of people explaining how it's wrong to associate Sanders with the Democratic Party, given his many ideological differences with it, and this is true.
